

Alberta PCAP Refresher Training: Overview

This document describes the course description, requirements and intended uses, and prices for the online refresher training.

Individual Refresher Training

Overview

The individual refresher training is a series of self-directed modules that reviews the information in the PCAP 3-Day Core Training. This training should take the participants approximately 10 hours to complete in its entirety. There are ten modules that cover PCAP foundational theory, mentor tasks and best practices, paper work, safety, and Penelope. Throughout the modules there are quizzes to test the participants knowledge, as well as written responses that act as an area of discussion and self-reflection.

A completion certificate will be sent to the participant upon the completion of all the modules, quizzes, and written responses.

Course Requirements

The completion of the in person 3-Day Core Training is a pre-requisite to taking the online refresher training. It is suggested by the Alberta PCAP Council that the refresher training be taken 12-18 months after the initial 3-Day Core Training.

Pricing

Please note that the course training is listed in US dollars. Converted, the course is priced at \$125.00 for non-members and \$150.00 for out of province users. PCAP members receive a 20% discount, the discount code is available on the members' website. Visit www.members.alberta-pcap.ca to purchase or renew a PCAP membership, valid for one year after purchase.

This document shows users how to get started with PCAP online training and how to take the PCAP refresher training.


1. Registering and Logging in



1. Select 'Create Account' if you are a first time user.

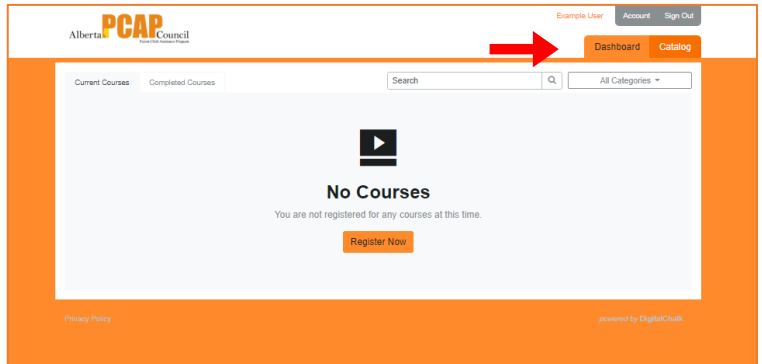

2. Selecting Courses

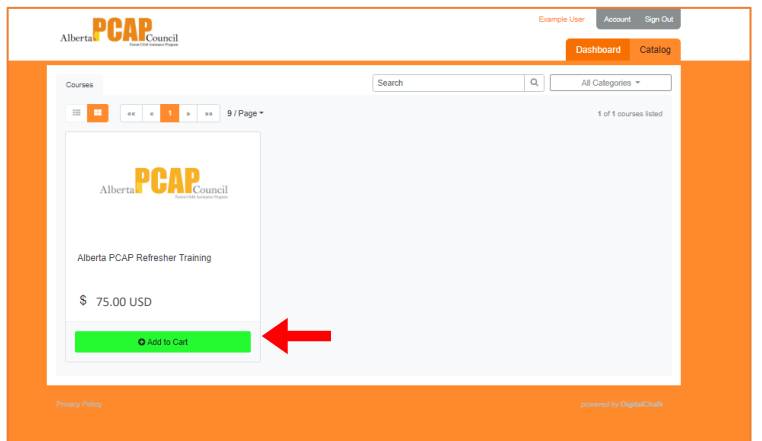
After initial set-up, you can access the site by signing in on the main page. Once logged in, you will be brought to the Dashboard page. Any courses you are currently registered in will appear here. In the top right corner are the options to view your account details or sign out.

1. Select 'Catalog' next to the Dashboard tab to view available courses.

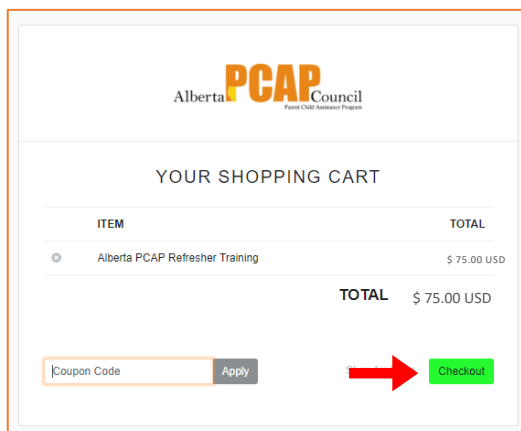


2. Select 'Add to Cart' below the course you want to take to add it to your shopping cart.

** Please note that the courses are listed in US dollars.*

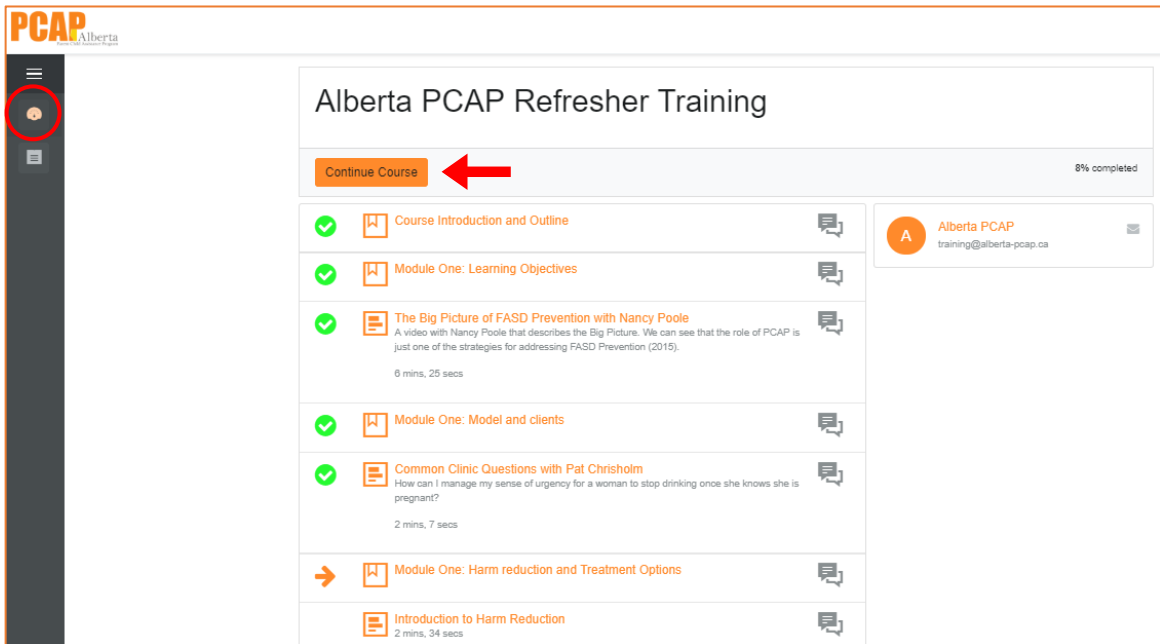


3. Review order details in the Shopping Cart and select 'Checkout' to complete the purchase via credit card.



3. Taking the Course

The course can be accessed from the Dashboard page. Courses will save progress as you complete sections and can be returned to at a later time. Once in the course, the modules will be displayed in the order you should take them. Select the Dashboard icon in the top left to return to the Dashboard.



1. Navigate the course by selecting 'Start Course' from the top, or by selecting the element from the list.
2. Complete the slides, quiz, video resource, and written answer portions for each module.

How to view quiz answers

The passing grade for a quiz is 100% and there are unlimited attempts. Select 'Review last attempt' to review answers. Select on the quiz itself to retake.

How to turn on video subtitles

Hover over the video and select the 'CC' option in the bottom right corner to turn on video subtitles.

How to access your Completion Certificate

The Completion Certificate will automatically download as a PDF once all elements are completed.

4. Editing Account Information

Account details can be accessed by selecting 'Account' from the top right banner.



This will bring you to your account information page, where you can review your name and email details, and change your password.

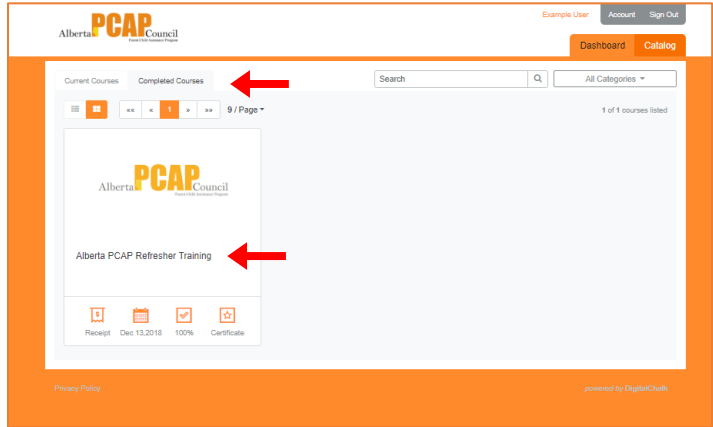
After making any changes, select 'Save' to update your changes.
